New Delhi: un estratto del romanzo "The Eyes of Darkness", un thriller del 1981 dell'autore di suspense bestseller Dean Koontz, ruota attorno ai social media che raccontano di un laboratorio militare cinese che crea un virus come parte del suo programma di armi biologiche.

Nel capitolo 39 del suo libro, Koontz scrive che il laboratorio si trova a Wuhan, che dà al virus il suo nome, Wuhan-400.

Le righe del libro dicevano: "Chiamano la roba 'Wuhan-400' perché è stata sviluppata nei loro laboratori RDNA fuori dalla città di Wuhan, ed era il quattrocentesimo ceppo vitale di microrganismi artificiali creati a quel centro . "

Twitterati ha inondato i social media con le loro reazioni.

Un utente ha scritto: " Haha, teorema della scimmia infinita. Scegli qualsiasi evento e le probabilità sono che qualche libro scritto in alcuni abbia una trama simile. La teoria della cospirazione non ha fine".

Un altro ha scritto: "Sensazionale ... Senza dubbio la Cina aveva sostituito la Russia e l'URSS come paese canaglia nei film di Hollywood e successivamente nei film di James Bond".

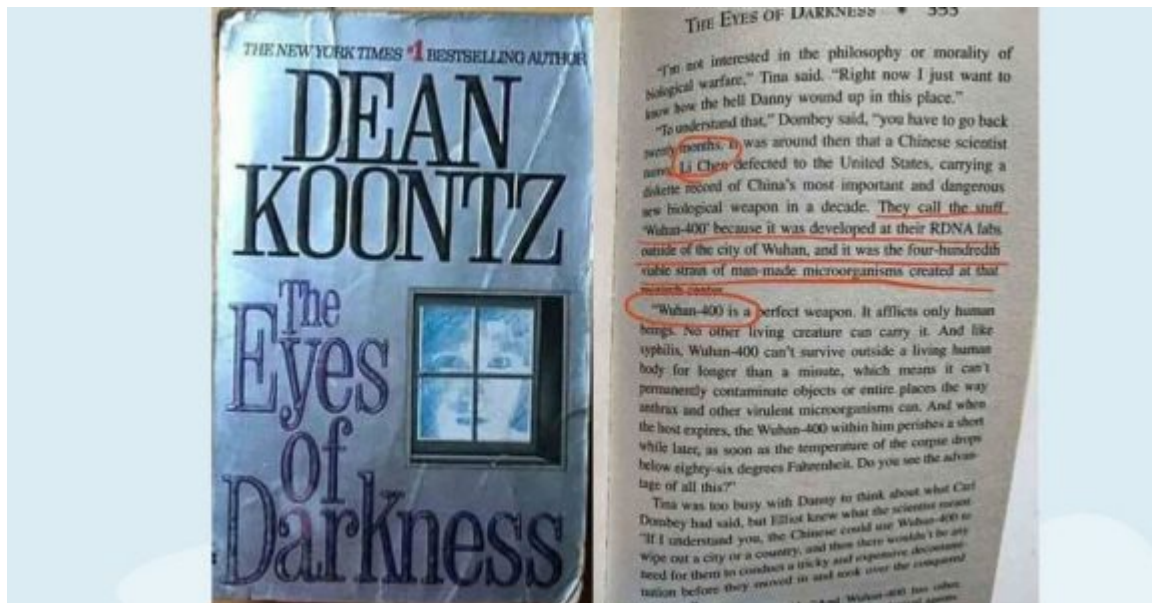
Un post recitava: "Sicuramente intrigante, spero che la verità venga fuori".

New Delhi: An excerpt of the Novel "The Eyes of Darkness", a 1981 thriller by bestselling suspense author Dean Koontz is revolving around the social media which tells of a Chinese military lab that creates a virus as part of its biological weapons programme.

In chapter 39 of his book, Koontz writes that the lab is located in Wuhan, which lends the virus its name, Wuhan-400.

The lines from the book read: "They call the stuff 'Wuhan-400' because it was developed at their RDNA labs outside of the city of Wuhan, and it was the four-hundredth viable strain of man-made micro-organisms created at that centre."

Twitterati flooded social media with their reactions.

A user wrote, "Haha Infinite monkey theorem. Pick any event and chances are that some book written at some would have a similar plot. Conspiracy theory has no end."

Another wrote, "Sensational ... No doubt China had replaced Russia and USSR as the rogue country in Hollywood films and later James Bond movies."

A post read, "Intriguing for sure, hope the truth comes out."

A user remarked, "Okay if it is then it surely backfired on them!"

By the end of Sunday, a total of 1,770 people had died of the disease and 70,548 confirmed cases of novel coronavirus infection had been reported in 31 provincial-level regions and the Xinjiang Production and Construction Corps in China.
